Host Violins of Hope at your school. For either of these options, we can bring one or more of the violins from the collection for your orchestra teachers and/or musicians to play.

Small classroom engagement, led by a docent, during a classroom period with dialogue for student inclusion and discussion

Assembly in the auditorium for a larger audience. This choice could also include a musical component to the program.
